We are pleased to introduce the newly expanded Illiana Surgical Quality Improvement Collaborative (ISQIC) and to invite hospitals in Illinois and Indiana to join us. ISQIC was established in 2014, when 56 hospitals in Illinois partnered to improve the quality of surgical care statewide. Other states such as Michigan, Florida and Tennessee have established similar collaboratives which have realized significant reductions in surgical morbidity with considerable corresponding cost savings. The Illiana Collaborative will be the first such regional partnership, and we welcome all hospitals to participate.

ISQIC'S STRATEGIES FOR IMPROVEMENT

1. Guided Implementation

Surgeon QI mentors, Process improvement coaches, Coordinating Center support, Engagement visits to member hospitals

2. Education

Quality and process improvement methods training, Leadership engagement plans, Collaborative-wide meetings

3. Comparative Reports

State- and region-specific benchmarked quality reports with risk-adjusted reports for ACS NSQIP hospitals, Return-on-investment reports

4. Collaborative QI Projects

Structured local and regional QI initiatives with intensive project support from ISQIC Coordinating Center

5. Networking

Opportunities to network with other hospitals, get advice, share experiences, connect with your hospital leadership
